The St. Elizabeth's Knights of Columbus 8th Annual Golf Tournament is scheduled for Saturday, August 22<sup>nd</sup>, at Blackhawk Golf Club with an 8am shotgun start. The format is four-man scramble with no handicaps. The tournament fee of \$65 per player includes: range balls, cart, greens fee, and food and drink afterward. It also covers cash prizes for the top four teams and individual prizes on many holes – longest drive, closest to the pin, longest putt made, etc. We will follow standard four-man scramble rules, and you will have to take at least two drives per player. Each player will be allowed to purchase one mulligan for \$10 or two for \$15 either with the registration fee or when he signs in before beginning the round.

Based on 100 or more players the payouts per team will be as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> place: \$400  
2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$300  
3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$200  
4<sup>th</sup> place: \$100

In addition to the cash payouts, there will be raffles for free rounds of golf, gift certificates to the pro shop, and other great prizes. Each player will also receive a goodie bag containing gifts or coupons.

Please send in your teams as soon as possible so that we can begin to set up the rosters. If you want to play but don't have a team, we will place you on one. Good luck and we look forward to seeing you there. Also, please forward this email to anyone who may be interested in enjoying some good golf. We will e-mail an update on Friday, August 21<sup>st</sup>, with the final rosters plus details of the contests and prizes that will be offered.
