

2009 Christmas Parade

Parade day instructions

The parade is 1.3 miles long from the starting point to the finish. It will start at the intersection of Pfennig Lane and Railroad Avenue at Park Crest Middle School (PCMS) at 6pm.

You have been assigned a line-up location along Pfennig Lane running west of Park Crest MS. Slot 1 will be at the corner with Railroad Ave. See detailed map for the line-up layout.

Use Swenson Farms Blvd (in front of Pflugerville HS) to go the line-up area if coming from south or west of Pflugerville. This saves you fighting traffic and puts you facing the right direction on Pfennig.

Parking

No parking is allowed in the line-up area or along Pfennig Lane. You may drop off parade participants at the line-up area, but all extra vehicles and support vehicles must be removed from the area by 5pm. Pflugerville PD will keep traffic flowing in that area until the parade starts.

Parking for support vehicles will be available at Park Crest Middle School, St Elizabeth Church (just behind PCMS), and at Brookhollow Elementary and in the field across from it (approximate midpoint of the parade route).

If you have a large trailer, we suggest parking it in the field behind St Elizabeth church (see detailed line-up map). After dropping off your group or equipment, turn left on Railroad and take the first driveway on the left. **Beware that it is a very steep turn.**

There is a 6pm Mass at St. Elizabeth that uses most of the parking lot, so be considerate parking there.

Parade precautions

Floats, trailers, and trucks that carry parade participants must operate in a safe manner. If children are riding on any part of the parade vehicle, there must be adult supervision at all times. The adults must be in the same location as the children, i.e. if the children are on the trailer or truck bed, adults must ride with them on the trailer or in the truck bed. **Do not throw anything from floats and trailers.**

At another local parade near Pflugerville, a child was killed when she fell from a float while reaching off of the trailer trying to retrieve a loose rope. **Adult supervision is absolutely required.**

Pflugerville PD Rules and Regulations

- **Do not move any traffic cones in the line-up area or along the parade route.**
- **All floats must be lighted.**
- **All vehicles must have their parking lights on during the parade.**
- **Only people walking alongside the float are allowed to throw candy.**
